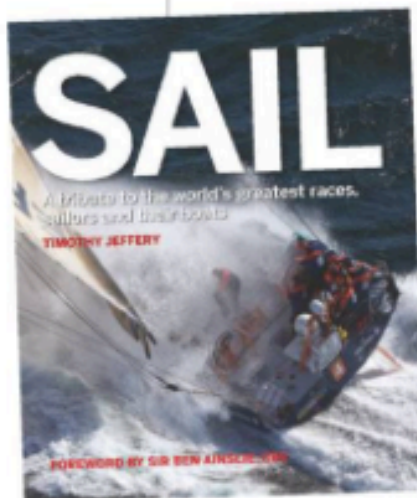

Perini Navi reveals designs for 47m sailing superyacht

NEW DESIGN

Italian yard Perini Navi has revealed plans for a 47 metre flybridge sailing yacht, which was developed by its in-house design team. This high-performance sloop boasts 42 square metres of deck space and a sail plan totalling 2,315 square metres.

The as-yet-unnamed project features a retractable keel, meaning the draft can be reduced from 9.5 metres to 3.9 metres when the owner wants to access shallow anchorages.

Key features include proprietary captive reel winches and furling systems, as well as Perini Navi's patented fly-by-wire steering system, which delivers a tactile cruising experience at the helm.

The sailing yacht accommodates eight guests split across a full-beam and staff of up to eight people.



Feadship launches 96.55m Project Vertigo

Feadship has launched their third largest yacht to date, the 96.55m Project Vertigo. Scheduled for delivery in 2017, the yacht is currently for sale. She has a steel hull and aluminium superstructure. Redman Whiteley Dixon was responsible for her exterior design, Chahan Interior for the interior and De Voogt

Naval Architects for the naval architecture.

Project Vertigo will accommodate 18 guests in 7 double cabins and 2 twins, as well as a crew of 34. Project Vertigo's amenities include a spa with a pool aft of the main deck, a beach club with a bar located under the pool and a private cinema.

Tankoa Yachts new 58m Open Concept

NEW DESIGN

Tankoa Yachts has joined forces with Francesco Paszkowski to create what would be its fastest yacht to date. The 58m Open concept will reach a maximum speed of 30 knots.

The superyacht has a streamlined profile and features two sprawling aft decks and open sundeck, which hosts a central bar and an alfresco dining area for up to 10 guests. Performance wise the vessel will be powered by a triple 2,683hp MTU engine set-up, twin Kamewa water jets and a central booster.
