







Pounded in 2008. Tankoa Yachts is a boutique yard that builds quality yachts of between 50 and 90 metres. Its latest offering is a 58-metre Open concept penned by the Francesco Paszkowski Design, yielding a sleek, aggressive profile that screams eagerness and speed. The Genoese yard crafted the new yacht to be light, slender, powerful and comfortable because it is very much of the opinion that luxury yachting should never mean compromising on fast and free exhilarating speed. The Tankoa 58m Open Concept's hull and superstructure are both made entirely from 5085 alloy. It is powered by three 2,000 kW MTU coupled with two Kamewa Water Jets with a central booster, bow thruster and gyroscopic stabilisers. What all that

technology amounts to in practice is a very brisk 28/50 knots at half-load. Tankoa is a yard with strong core values: it keeps its output limited, focuses on detailing, adopts the newest technologies and delivers an impressive spec. Ethics and an emphasis on Italian construction excellence are other bywords. This 58-metre is the latest product of that philosophy. It will be fully-customised to suit the needs and tastes of its very fortunate owner too. The internationally-renowned designer Francesco Paszkowski, and naval architect Vincenzo Ruggiero, have been involved with Tankoa since its earliest day and are currently working together on the new 71-metre \$701.
