## Out on her own

Tankoa shows that siblings can still be individuals, says *Raphael Montigneaux*

She may be a sister to Tankoa's 2015 launch *Suerte*, but the Genoa shipyard's fresh flagship, 72m *Solo*, is aptly named. The stern was lengthened from the previous design, while an underwater exhaust opens up space on the main and sundecks. Lower down, a longer skeg

means an extended waterline and higher top speed of 17.5 knots. Design is by Francesco Paszkowski, who worked with Margherita Casprini on the interior, which sleeps 12 guests.
